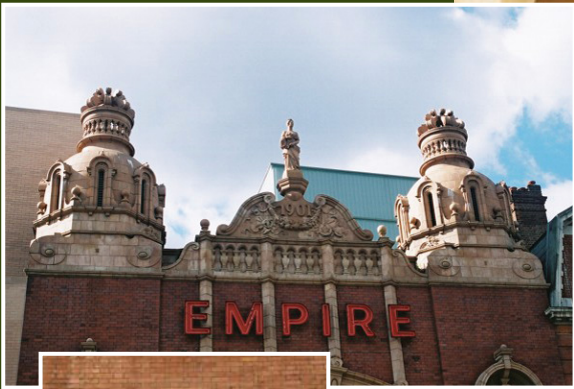

## Hackney Empire Theatre

Hackney Empire in London's East End was built by Frank Matcham in 1901 and is one of the finest surviving Victorian Variety Theatres in Britain.

PAYE Stonework were appointed to repair and restore the original facades and design, manufacture and install the contemporary terracotta facade and letters on the new corner building.

The building achieved numerous awards including Building of the Year: Conservation 2004. The giant terracotta letters of its facade proclaim the theatre and the heart of Hackney and explore the boundaries of traditional materials within a contemporary setting.
