Tonbridge Castle Gatehouse

On August 30th 1999, The Gatehouse at Tonbridge Castle closed to visitors, and work on a £375,000 millennium project began. The missing floors on the ground floor and first floor levels were replaced, and the spiral staircase in the East Tower repaired.

This enabled a circular tour of the Gatehouse to be possible. In replacing the floors, two additional rooms were created.

An educational room mainly for school and group use, provision for an exhibition space for local community use, and a second venue for Civil Marriage ceremonies has been provided.

PAYE's craftsmen were instrumental in ensuring that the conservation works to the masonry was of the highest quality and in keeping with the fabric of the medieval gatehouse.
