St Pauls Church Mill Hill

The Church was originally built by William Wilberforce in 1830 and sits prominently on The Ridgeway in Mill Hill.

Paye Stonework were appointed to complete the re-rendering of the external walls, structural works to the internal chancel arch and re-roofing and works to the external stone windows.

The works to the external fabric involved the removal of almost 100% of the stucco render which was loose and defective. Then using traditional craft skills the render was applied to flat areas and moulded profiles using zinc profiler blocks and travelers.

A major part of the project was the stone replacement to the main window.
